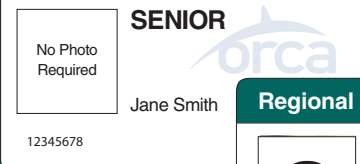

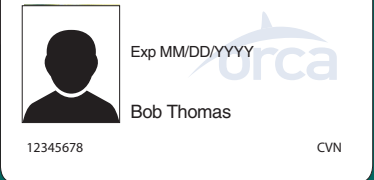

## Loading Money & Passes onto RRFP

### E-Purse

- Load any amount, from \$5 to \$300, on your RRFP card.
- E-purse funds are used to pay your transit fare and don't expire!



### OR

### Monthly Passes

- Save money and get unlimited travel on transit services for a calendar month.
- Great option if you use transit 5 days a week.

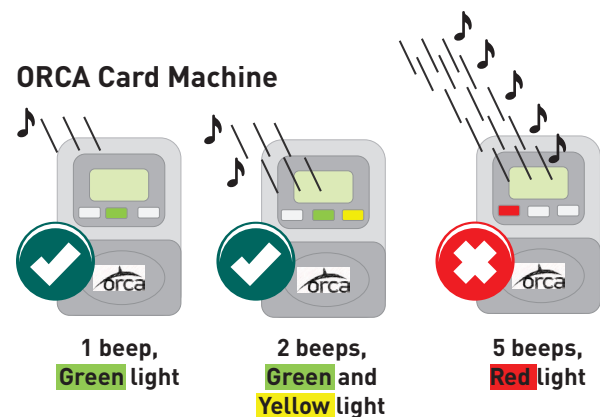


## How to Pay

- On the bus, tap when you board.
- On bus rapid transit, tap at the platform reader before you board. If there is no card reader, tap when you board.
- For the ferry, tap at the turnstile. Or, staff will tap your card on their handheld card reader.
- On a streetcar, tap at the platform reader before you board.
- For the train and light rail, tap at the reader on the station platform prior to boarding. Tap off when you exit so the correct fare is calculated.



### ORCA Card Machine



Add money or a monthly pass soon!

You do not have enough money on your ORCA card or your pass has expired. Pay cash.

## Transfers with Loaded RRFP Cards

- **Cards replace paper transfer slips**
  - Free transfers on a participating transit agency within 2 hours of your last ride
