### **Summary**

South Park Senior Center is seeking a part-time social worker to assist in the areas of medical, economic, environmental, and psycho-social health to vulnerable older adults in King County. This position will provide case management for seniors age 50 and older for those living with disabilities. This role will be part of a social worker team focused on reducing barriers of equity and inclusion; the role will include problem solving, arranging for services and resources, advocating for individuals, and establishing and maintaining educational and group-oriented supports.

### **GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Provide case management services while performing comprehensive psychosocial assessment of participants; make referrals and coordinate for services such as mental health, home health, government subsidies and food security.
- Assist in establishing culturally sensitive programming and resources that serve to meet the needs and interests of participants.
- Ensure HIPAA protocols are adhered to within work with clients.
- Perform other duties as required.

### **QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS**

- Bachelor's degree in social work or related field preferred, with two years of paid experience.
- Bilingual Khmer/English required.
- Experience working with the elderly and/or persons with disabilities.
- Familiarity with the Cambodian and/or Vietnamese social service network.

SPSC is located in the South Park Neighborhood Center, in the heart of South Park where we provide services in a historic brick fire station. SPSC works to support seniors, and those living with disabilities, as they explore healthy and active lives. Our participants are primarily of Asian descent, many are navigating language and cultural barriers, and most are living at, or below, the poverty line.

SPSC is a vibrant place for community to gather, friends to be made, and culture to be celebrated. Our Seniors gather (outside of pandemic conditions) to enjoy homemade meals, singing, dancing, exercise classes, education and learning opportunities, and specialized programming. As many of our Seniors are living vulnerable lives, SPSC is also a place they can receive social service supports and resources.

SPSC partners with, and is funded by, King County and the City of Seattle as we work together to meet the needs of our community. SPSC has many affiliations and partnerships within the human services and non-profit sectors as we collaborate to bridge gaps in services, meet overlooked needs with the community, and grow aspects of equity and inclusion.
